

Senior Football Championship:

1. Sixteen clubs shall play in the Senior Championship.
 2. All Clubs shall play two games at home and two games away in the sixteen club League stage of the championship.
 3. For Round 1, eight teams shall be drawn in order to play at home and eight teams in order shall be drawn to play away to make up eight ties.
 4. Those teams drawn to play at home in Round 1 shall make up Pool A and the teams drawn to play away in Round 1 shall make up Pool B
 5. For Round 2; the home teams shall be drawn from Pool B with the away teams will be drawn from Pool A.
 6. For Round 3; the home teams shall be drawn from Pool A with the away teams will be drawn from Pool B.
 7. For Round 4; the home teams shall be drawn from Pool B with the away teams will be drawn from Pool A.
- No club shall play another club more than once in the league stage, and the CCC shall adjust the draw accordingly if necessary.
- Points from all ties will be awarded on the basis of two points for a win and one point for a draw.
- All sixteen Final placings shall be decided in compliance with Rial 6.21.
- All Clubs will be placed in numbered descending order with the highest placed club numbered 1 and the lowest numbered sixteen .
- Knockout**
- The four quarter finals pairings shall be
1st v8th ; 2nd v7th; 3rd v6th; 4thv5th.
- Teams 1-4 shall play at home
- The winners of each quarter finals will be drawn randomly to decide the semi final pairings.
- The winners of the semifinals will play in the 2020 Donegal Senior Championship Final.
- Relegation**
- The bottom four clubs will play off over two rounds to decide the club to be relegated.
- Relegation Round 1 : 13th v 16th; 14th v 15th.
- Relegation Round 2 : The losing clubs from Relegation Round 1 shall play and the losing club will be relegated to play in the 2021 Intermediate championship

Junior Football Championship:

1. Ten clubs shall play in the Junior Championship.
 2. The clubs shall be drawn into two groups A & B of five and all clubs shall play two games at home and two games away in the League stage.
- Points from all ties will be awarded on the basis of two points for a win and one point for a draw.
- All five final group placings shall be decided in compliance with Rial 6.21.
- Knockout**
- The 1st team in each group shall progress to the semi finals
- The two quarter finals pairings shall be
2nd Group A v 3rd Group B; 2nd Group B v 3rd Group A
- 2nd placed teams to play at home
- The winners of each quarter final and the two group winners will be drawn randomly to decide the semi final pairings.
- The winners of the semi finals will play in the 2020 Donegal Junior Championship Final with the winners promoted to the 2021

Senior Hurling Championship

1. Five clubs shall play in the Senior Hurling Championship.
 2. Each club shall play each other once with each club playing two games at home and two games away.
- Points from all ties will be awarded on the basis of two points for a win and one point for a draw.
- All five final group placings shall be decided in compliance with Rial 6.21.
- All Clubs will be placed in numbered descending order with the highest placed club numbered 1 and the lowest numbered five. The semi final pairings shall be 1st v 4th; 2nd v 3rd.

Junior Hurling Championship

1. Eight clubs shall play in the Junior Hurling Championship.
 2. The clubs will be drawn into two groups of four A & B. and allocated numbers 1 to 4.
 3. The order of play shall be 1v2; 3v4; 2v3; 4v1; 1v 3; 2v 4.
- Points from all ties will be awarded on the basis of two points for a win and one point for a draw.
- All four final group placings shall be decided in compliance with Rial 6.21.
- The winners of each group shall progress to the semi finals.
- The two quarter finals pairings shall be
2nd Group A v 3rd Group B; 2nd Group B v 3rd Group A
- 2nd placed teams to play at home
- The semi final pairings shall be drawn randomly

Intermediate Football Championship:

1. Twelve clubs shall play in the Intermediate Championship.
 2. All Clubs shall play two games at home and two games away in the Twelve club League stage of the championship.
 - 3 Each club shall be allocated fixtures against a grid numbered 1to12
- Points from all ties will be awarded on the basis of two points for a win and one point for a draw.
- All twelve final placings shall be decided in compliance with Rial 6.21.
- All Clubs will be placed in numbered descending order with the highest placed club numbered 1 and the lowest numbered twelve.
- Knockout**
- The four quarter finals pairings shall be
1st v8th ; 2nd v7th; 3rd v6th; 4thv5th.
- Teams 1-4 shall play at home.
- The winners of each quarter final will be drawn randomly to decide the semi final pairings.
- The winners of the semi finals will play in the 2020 Donegal Intermediate Championship Final with the winners promoted to the 2021 Senior Championship
- Relegation**
- The bottom four clubs will play off over two rounds to decide the club to be relegated.
- Relegation Round 1 : 9th v 12th; 10th v 11th.
- Relegation Round 2 : The losing clubs from Relegation Round 1 shall play and the losing club will be relegated to play in the 2021 Junior championship

Senior Football Reserve Championship:

1. Sixteen clubs shall play in the Senior Reserve Championship.
 2. The clubs shall play the same clubs home and away as determined by the draw for the Senior Championship
 3. The CCC may adjust the order of play.
- Points from all ties will be awarded on the basis of two points for a win and one point for a draw.
- All sixteen Final placings shall be decided in compliance with Rial 6.21.
- All Clubs will be placed in numbered descending order with the highest placed club numbered 1 and the lowest numbered sixteen
- Knockout**
- The four quarter final pairings shall be
1st v8th ; 2nd v7th; 3rd v6th; 4thv5th.
- Teams 1-4 shall play at home
- The winners of each quarter finals will be drawn randomly to decide the semi final pairings.
- The winners of the semifinals will play in the 2020 Donegal Senior Reserve Championship Final.

Intermediate Football Championship:

1. Twelve clubs shall play in the Intermediate Reserve Championship.
 2. The clubs shall play the same clubs home and away as determined by the draw for the Intermediate Championship.
 3. The CCC may adjust the order of play. Points from all ties will be awarded on the basis of two points for a win and one point for a draw.
- All twelve final placings shall be decided in compliance with Rial 6.21.
- All Clubs will be placed in numbered descending order with the highest placed club numbered 1 and the lowest numbered twelve.
- Knockout**
- The four quarter finals pairings shall be
1st v8th ; 2nd v7th; 3rd v6th; 4thv5th.
- Teams 1-4 shall play at home.
- The winners of each quarter final will be drawn randomly to decide the semi final pairings.
- The winners of the semi finals will play in the 2020 Donegal Intermediate Championship Final

All County Leagues

While most of the focus understandably has been on Club Championship structures, in order to provide a reasonable number of games during the remainder of 2020 for the club players then some type of League structures will be necessary to cater for the players including during the period after the club championships have concluded and inter county training and games have commenced. As promotion/relegation in Leagues have already been ruled out in 2020 by the CCC for very valid reasons then some new ideas around league structures are necessary to hopefully retain as much of the traditional and enviable competitive attractiveness of Donegal Gaa's League structures. We are also required to reduce the travel requirements on our clubs where possible. In line with these aims, the following has been decided;

- That for 2020 The league shall be organised as two divisions i.e. Division 1 & Division 2
 Division 1 shall consist of the teams who were to play in the 2020 divisions 1 & 2.
 Division 2 shall consist of the teams who were to play in the 2020 divisions 3 & 4.

Division 1

In Division 1 there shall be three sections, two of seven clubs and one of six clubs based on geographical proximity as shown.

Each team shall play each other once in their respective sections. The winners of each section shall be allocated a home game in the quarter finals. The remaining home venue shall be drawn out from the three sectional runners up, all of whom shall also play in the quarter final ties. The remaining two quarter final places shall be drawn from the three third placed teams in the three sections. The winning teams from these ties shall play in the semi-finals with the winners progressing to play in the All County League Division 1 Final.

Division 2

In Division 2 there shall be three sections, two of six clubs and one of seven clubs based on geographical proximity as shown.

Each team shall play each other once in their respective sections. The winners of each section will play in the semi finals and two shall be drawn to play at home. The remaining semi final place shall be taken from the section 2nd placed teams which will be decided by lot. The winners progressing to play in the All County League Division 2 Final.

Reserve Leagues

The Reserve league shall also be split into two Divisions 1&2 and be played midweek with Friday night the default night for fixtures. If numbers permit, the teams shall be in the same sections as their 1st teams

Division 1

Each team shall play each other once in their respective sections. The winners of each section will play in the semi finals and two shall be drawn to play at home. The remaining semi final place shall be taken from the section 2nd placed teams which will be decided by lot. The winners progressing to play in the All County Reserve League Division 1 Final.
